APPROVE OR AMEND AGENDA: It was moved by Jensen, seconded by Hardy to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried with voice vote.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE LIND TOWN BOARD MEETING, February 15th, 2021: It was moved by Hardy, seconded by Jensen to approve the minutes from the Lind Town Board meeting, February 15th, 2021. Motion carried with voice vote.

DISCUSSION AND/OR APPROVAL ZONING MAP AMENDMENT APPLICATION – Gregory Gill, Sr.- Parcel number 12-19-34-3: Discussion was held. It was moved by Gall, seconded by Hardy to approve zoning map amendment for Gregory Gill, parcel number 12-19-34-3. Motion carried with voice vote.

REPORT BY TOWN PLANNING COMMISSION: No meeting was held for the month of March. The next planning commission meeting will be held Wednesday, April 7th, 2021 at 7 p.m. at the Lind Town Hall.

DISCUSS REZONING REQUEST FROM JUSTIN WALSH – FROM COMMERCIAL TO INDUSTRIAL (old Kniesler trucking property): Discussion was held with the Town Board not being in favor of the rezoning from Commercial to Industrial.

DISCUSS LIND CENTER CEMETERY:

1. Discuss and/or approve Lind Center Cemetery Ordinance 2021-1 Discussion was held. Additional research will be conducted prior to next month's meeting. Postponed until next month.
2. Discuss and/or approve quote for mowing: The quote from John Gunderson for mowing of the Lind Center Cemetery was reviewed by the Town Board: Mow and trim - \$425.00; Additional mowing - \$50/hr. trim around trees, curbs, fencing, blowing of leaves - \$40/hr.

DISCUSS ROADS, DRIVEWAYS, CULVERTS AND SNOWPLOWING:

1. Intersection of Hwy EE/Lind Center Road – Casey Beyersdorf, Waupaca County Highway Commissioner: Casey reported currently there is a 3 way stop; This intersection has not had a lot of accidents; To reconstruct the intersection would cost between \$200,000-\$250,000. Discussion was held. The conclusion at this time would be to install a 4 way stop. Casey also reviewed the County road projects for the upcoming 2021 year.
2. Discuss and/or approve Resolution 2021-3 Town of Lind Resolution To Impose Special Charge For Current Services To Repair Right-Of-Way Excavations On Airport Road By Pionke Property. Postponed until next month.
3. Discuss Darwin Pionke complaint- Chairman Gall will contact Attorney Carlson for clarifications on questions Chairman Gall has. Postponed until next month.
4. Chairman Gall reported on the following: Casey Hones from the DNR contacted Chairman Gall on the moving of the road, widening of the shoulders. This will be addressed during the Spring Road Tour.
5. Setting date for Spring Road Tour – Will be held Sunday, April 11th at 7:30 p.m.

REPORT BY COUNTY BOARD SUPERVISORS: Hardy complimented the presentation given by Casey Beyersdorf. Golding reported the Masonic Temple in Manawa is where vaccinations are being given if you qualify.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Chairman Gall commented on the upcoming road tour.
